

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene [WASH]

The provision of safe water and sanitation is a fundamental human right and also essential to every humanitarian response. Effective WASH programmes can dramatically reduce the number of deaths from water-borne diseases such as cholera and diarrhea. Technical training and capacity building within the WASH community ensures a more predictable, timely and coherent humanitarian response. This is a specialized training course for the humanitarians which includes best practices through **Sphere Standards**, the essentials of water supply, BOQs for engineering works, vector control, excreta disposal and disaster waste; as well as technical modules on urban flooding, disposal of dead bodies in emergencies, WASH-related diseases, needs assessments and ground water pumping etc. The workshop aims to enable more people to carry out technical WASH work in the humanitarian response to a disaster.
