INTRODUCTION

Results based management is a management approach whereby an organization ensures that all of its processes, products and services contribute to the achievement of desired results. It depends on clearly defined accountability for results, and requires systematic monitoring, self-assessment and reporting on progress. It is a planning approach with a range of tools that ensures planning of different tiers of results with a defined set of indicators, outer context and environment. The Project Design Matrix evolves as a product of different analysis and ensures a built in monitoring, reporting, budgeting, and evaluation mechanism. It promotes a culture of accountability and a sense of ownership in the organizations leading towards more realistic set of plans that can be monitored as part of the overall management process. This approach facilitates managers/ authorities to take critical decisions at different phases of the project life cycle without compromising on the achievement of results.
