He also taught as an Adjunct Professor of Religion at Arcadia University and the Reconstruction is Rabbinical College.

Mr. Adnan received his Juris Doctor in Law from the University of Pennsylvania, his M.L.S. in International Affairs from Georgetown University and his B.A. in Religion and Anthropology from Emory University. He has spent many years living and studying in Syria, Morocco, Yemen, Pakistan, Jordan, Kenya and Malawi.
